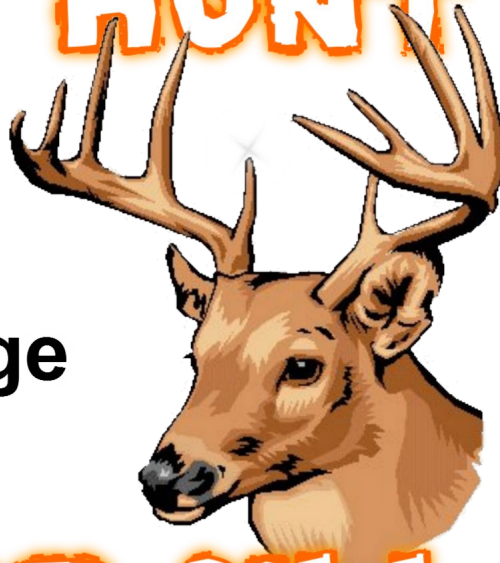

FORT SILL YOUTH DEER GUN HUNT

HUNT DATES: 22-23 OCTOBER (Saturday and Sunday)

A Youth Class Will Be Held On Friday 21 OCTOBER @1700

No Registration "Just Show up"

Food, Drinks and Door Prizes will be provided

1. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Any youth under the age of 18 years of age that is Hunter Education Certified, who is a dependant of Active Duty, Retired Military, Permanent Full-Time Fort Sill DAC or Fort Sill Regular Full Time NAF employee.

2. Each youth must have an accompanying adult age 21 or older who has a Fort Sill Sportsmen Range Safety Card and meet all state requirements established for the State Hunter Education Certification. The accompanying adult **may not** hunt or possess any firearms or archery equipment and must be in direct supervision, close enough to take immediate control of the firearm.

3. A Youth Deer drawing and educational briefing for Saturday's hunt will be held 1700 on Friday, 21 October 2021, in Bld. #1465. A second drawing will be held on Saturday, 22 October for Sunday's hunt and will start promptly at 1200 in Bldg. #1465, Sportsman Services

Food and drinks will be provided for the kids on Friday night drawing.

4. Safety: Safety and caution is the key to keeping this season accident free. **Blaze orange (hat & vest) is required while hunting; hunters should practice all gun safety rules.** During the youth Deer Gun season, a portion of Fort Sill's range training areas are closed to all other hunting activities.

5. License requirements: All state licensing requirements must be met. Requirement for Fort Sill hunting Permit for youths will be waived for this two day hunt only! **Please create a FREE iSportsman Account for your Child.**

Persons under 16 years of age are not required to have annual licenses or permits, but they are required to have any special tags required by the State for this age group (see current Oklahoma Hunting Guide).
