MEMORANDUM FOR ALL FISHING DERBY PARTICIPANTS

SUBJECT: 2024 Natural Resources 38th Annual Kids Fishing Derby

1. A kid's fishing derby is scheduled for Saturday 1 June 2024 at White Wolf Crossing from 07:30 – 10:00. A date will be announced on iSportsman homepage designating when fishing will be prohibited at Medicine Creek. The derby is open to all kids 3-15. No registration is required.
2. Children are allowed one fishing pole. Children must have their own bait, stringer or basket, and be accompanied by an adult. Each participant must keep their fish separate. Children may cull fish and keep a **6 catfish limit** during the derby.
 - a. Catfish must be at least 10" long
 - b. Bass between 13" and 16" must be returned to the water
3. Adults may only instruct their children in casting, retrieving, or landing fish during the derby. **Fishing by any adult is strictly prohibited.** Adults should express the importance of safety, sportsmanship, and conservation on children; particularly removal of litter, careful handling of unwanted fish, and explaining regulations that protect these resources.
4. Volunteers will assist Natural Resources personnel during the derby to ensure participants have an enjoyable experience. Interested in volunteering? Call Vici at 580.442.5916.
5. No pets are allowed, with the exception of service animals.
6. Inclement weather plan: if there is high water in the Medicine Creek area, it could force us to move to Miner pond. All updates will be posted on the iSportsman homepage.
